This Supplement dated 7 January 2009 (the **Supplement**) constitutes the second supplement to the base prospectus dated 3 November 2008 in relation to the LaunchPAD Programme for the Issuance of Credit Linked Notes (the **Credit Linked Notes Base Prospectus**) established by ABN AMRO Bank N.V. (the **Issuer**) approved by the AFM on 3 November 2008, as supplemented on 2 December 2008.
2. The Base Prospectus was approved as a base prospectus pursuant to Directive 2003/71/EC by the AFM. This Supplement constitutes a supplemental prospectus to the Base Prospectus for the purposes of Article 5:23 of the Financial Supervision Act (*Wet op het financieel toezicht*).
3. This Supplement is supplemental to, and should be read in conjunction with, the Base Prospectus and any other supplements thereto issued by the Issuer.
4. The Issuer accepts responsibility for the information contained in this Supplement. To the best of the knowledge of the Issuer (having taken all reasonable care to ensure that such is the case), the information contained in this Supplement is in accordance with the facts and does not omit anything likely to affect the import of such information.
5. In a Research Update dated 19 December 2008 the Ratings agency Standard & Poor's (**S&P**) has made public that it lowered the credit ratings of the Issuer to A+ (long term) and to A-1 (short-term).
6. This downgrade follows S&P's rating action on 12 U.S. and European financial institutions, including The Royal Bank of Scotland PLC (**RBS**) and reflects the expectation that, by the end of 2009, the Issuer and the majority of its obligations will be absorbed by RBS.
