This supplement (the "Supplement") is the third supplemental to the base prospectus dated 26 January 2017 (the "Base Prospectus") of the € 15,000,000,000 Covered Bond Programme (the "Programme") of de Volksbank N.V. (the "Issuer") and is prepared to update and amend the Base Prospectus as updated and supplemented following the first supplemental prospectus dated 23 February 2017 (the "First Supplemental Prospectus"), and the second supplemental prospectus dated 9 March 2017 (the "Second Supplemental Prospectus"), and is supplemental to, forms part of and should be read in conjunction with the Base Prospectus. Terms defined in the Base Prospectus shall have the same meaning in this Supplement, unless specified otherwise.

This document is an amendment and a supplement to the Base Prospectus within the meaning of article 16 of Directive 2003/71/EC including Directive 2010/73/EU (the "**PD Amending Directive**") (the "**Prospectus Directive**"). This Supplement has been approved by the Netherlands Authority for the Financial Markets ("**Stichting Autoriteit Financiële Marken**", the "**AFM**"), which is the Netherlands competent authority for the purpose of the Prospectus Directive and relevant implementing measures in the Netherlands, as a supplemental prospectus issued in compliance with the Prospectus Directive, Commission Regulation EC No. 809/2004 (the "**Prospectus Regulation**") and relevant implementing measures in the Netherlands for the purpose of giving information with regard to the issue of Covered Bonds under the Programme.

Subscribers for any Covered Bonds to be issued have the right to withdraw such subscription within two (2) business days following the publication of this Supplement.

The Issuer has requested the AFM to provide the competent authorities in Luxembourg with a certificate of approval, attesting that this Supplement has been drawn up in accordance with the Prospectus Directive, the Prospectus Regulation and relevant implementing measures in the Netherlands.

The Covered Bonds may not be offered, sold or delivered within the United States or to United States persons as defined in Regulation S under the Securities Act ("Regulation S"), except in certain transactions permitted by US tax regulations and the Securities Act. The Covered Bonds and the Guarantee have not been and will not be registered under the U.S. Securities Act of 1933, as amended, or the securities laws or any state of the U.S. or other jurisdiction. The securities may not be offered or sold within the U.S. or to, or for the account or benefit of U.S. persons (as defined in Regulation S), except pursuant to an exemption from, or in a transaction not subject to, the registration requirements of the Securities Act and applicable state or local securities laws. Accordingly, the Covered Bonds are being offered, sold or delivered only to non-U.S. persons (as defined in Regulation S) outside the U.S. in reliance on Regulation S.

To the extent that there is any inconsistency between (a) any statement in this supplement or any statement incorporated by reference into the Base Prospectus by this supplement and (b) any statement in the First Supplemental Prospectus, the Second Supplemental Prospectus or any statement in or incorporated by reference in the Base Prospectus, the statements under (a) above will prevail.

CERTAIN MODIFICATIONS TO THE BASE PROSPECTUS

The following are amendments to the text of the Base Prospectus.

References to page numbers are to page numbers of the Base Prospectus.

• On page 133 under the chapter "Covered Bonds" the following text shall be deleted:

(g) Set-off

- (i) Any payments under or pursuant to the Covered Bonds shall be made by the Issuer free of setoff and withholding if and to the extent so specified in the applicable Final Terms.
- (ii) If in the Final Terms "German Insurers" are indicated Applicable, each of the Issuer and the CBC hereby waives, for the benefit of all present and future holders of the Registered Covered Bonds issued in such Final Terms, any right to set-off ("verrekenen", in German: "aufrechnen") any amount against, any right to retain ("inhouden", in German: "zurückbehalten") any amount from, and any right of pledge ("pandrecht", in German: "Pfandrecht"), including but not limited to any right of pledge created under the Issuer's General Banking Conditions with regard to, any amount it owes under or in respect of the Registered Covered Bonds.

If this waiver under (g)(ii) is applicable it applies as far as and as long as the Registered Covered Bonds are part of the security funds ("Sicherungsvermögen") and the other restricted assets ("sonstiges gebundenes Vermögen") within the meaning of section 54 of the German Insurance Supervisory Act ("Versicherungsaufsichtgesetz") in connection with the German Regulation on the Investment of the Restricted Assets of Insurance Companies ("Verordnung über die Anlage des gebundenen Vermögen von Versicherungsunternehmen") also in case of an insolvency and (ii) prevails over any present or future agreement with a conflicting content, save in the case of future agreements only, where such future agreement has a conflicting content which explicitly refers to this specific waiver.

And replaced with:

(g) Set-off

- (i) Any payments under or pursuant to the Covered Bonds shall be made by the Issuer free of set-off and withholding if and to the extent so specified in the applicable Final Terms.
- (ii) If in the Final Terms "German Insurers" are indicated Applicable, each of the Issuer and the CBC hereby waives, for the benefit of all present and future holders of the Registered Covered Bonds issued in such Final Terms, any right to set-off ("verrekenen", in German: "aufrechnen") any amount against, any right to retain ("inhouden", in German: "zurückbehalten") any amount from, and any right of pledge ("pandrecht", in German: "Pfandrecht"), including but not limited to any right of pledge created under the Issuer's General Banking Conditions with regard to, any amount it owes under or in respect of the Registered Covered Bonds and any similar right which may adversely affect the rights under or in respect of Registered Covered Bonds.

If this waiver under (g)(ii) is applicable it (i) applies as far as and as long as the Registered Covered Bonds are part of the committed assets ("Sicherungsvermögen") of an insurer within the meaning of section 125 of the German Insurance Supervisory Act ("Versicherungsaufsichtgesetz") as amended from time to time also in case of an insolvency and (ii) prevails over any present or future agreement with a conflicting content, save in the case of future agreements only, where such future agreement has a conflicting content which explicitly refers to this specific waiver.
