This supplement (the "Supplement") is the first supplement to the base prospectus dated 30 May 2022 (the "Base Prospectus") of the Euro 10,000,000,000 Covered Bond Programme (the "Programme") of NIBC Bank N.V. (the "Issuer") and is prepared to update and amend the Base Prospectus and is supplemental to, forms part of and should be read in conjunction with the Base Prospectus. Capitalised terms used herein will have the meaning as defined in the Base Prospectus, unless specified otherwise herein.

This document is an amendment and a supplement to the Base Prospectus within the meaning of Regulation (EU) 2017/1129 (the "Prospectus Regulation"). This Supplement has been approved by the Dutch Authority for the Financial Markets (*Stichting Autoriteit Financiële Markten*) (the "AFM") as competent authority under the Prospectus Regulation for the purpose of giving information with regard to the issue of Covered Bonds under the Programme. The AFM only approves this Supplement as meeting the standards of completeness, comprehensibility and consistency imposed by the Prospectus Regulation. Such approval should not be considered as an endorsement of the Issuer and or the CBC that is the subject of this Supplement nor as an endorsement of the quality of any Covered Bonds that are the subject of this Supplement. Investors should make their own assessment as to the suitability of investing in the Covered Bonds.
