



Sale of Leadbitter by Heijmans final

's-Hertogenbosch, March 17 2011 - The sale by Heijmans of British property developer Leadbitter to the management of Leadbitter and the French Bouygues Bâtiment International (BBI) has been completed. On 23 December 2010, Heijmans reached complete agreement on the sale, whereupon the relevant competition authority was consulted. March 1st, Heijmans received final approval from the competition authority. Yesterday, March 16, the share transfer took place.

The sale of Leadbitter fits into Heijmans' strategic choice to focus principally on strong positions on the Netherlands and de Belgian infra market. Leadbitter develops and builds public-sector rented homes, and property in the social (e.g. schools and hospitals) and leisure sectors. Leadbitter is led by Bob Rendell and Paul Abson.
