**REINET INVESTMENTS S.C.A. SHARE BUYBACK PROGRAMME – UPDATE 7 MAY 2019**

Reinet Investments S.C.A. has repurchased 158 779 ordinary shares in the period 29 April to 3 May 2019. The shares were repurchased on the Johannesburg Stock Exchange at an average price of ZAR 239.81 per share (highest price: ZAR 242.00; lowest price: ZAR 236.99) for a total consideration of some ZAR 38.08 million (€ 2.4 million), plus transaction costs. These repurchases were made as part of the share buyback programme announced on 6 February 2019.

The total number of shares repurchased under this programme to date is 2 670 693 ordinary shares for a total consideration of some ZAR 620.53 million (€ 38.7 million), plus transaction costs.
