## Van Lanschot Kempen: update on share buy-back programme 26 March 2019 – 1 April 2019

Amsterdam/'s-Hertogenbosch, the Netherlands, 2 April 2019

In the period from 26 March 2019 until 1 April 2019 Van Lanschot Kempen has repurchased 24,753 of its own shares (depositary receipts for Class A ordinary shares). The shares were repurchased at an average price of €20.28 per share for a total amount of €502,029.

These repurchases are part of the share buy-back programme for at most 370,000 of own shares, which was announced on 21 February 2019. The total number of shares repurchased to date is 108,891.
