

### Société Générale SA shareholding notification

ArcelorMittal ('the Company') announces that Société Générale SA has notified it of a shareholding decrease in ArcelorMittal from 5.01% to 4.76% as based on an amended form submitted on 19 November 2020. The notification is available in the Luxembourg Stock Exchange's electronic database OAM on <a href="http://corporate.arcelormittal.com">www.bourse.lu</a> and on <a href="http://corporate.arcelormittal.com">http://corporate.arcelormittal.com</a> under 'Investors - Corporate Governance - Shareholding structure'.

This notification was published in reference to the Luxembourg law and the Grand Ducal regulation of 11 January 2008, on transparency requirements for issuers of securities ('Transparency Law') in view of a shareholding notification going below the 5% voting rights threshold.
